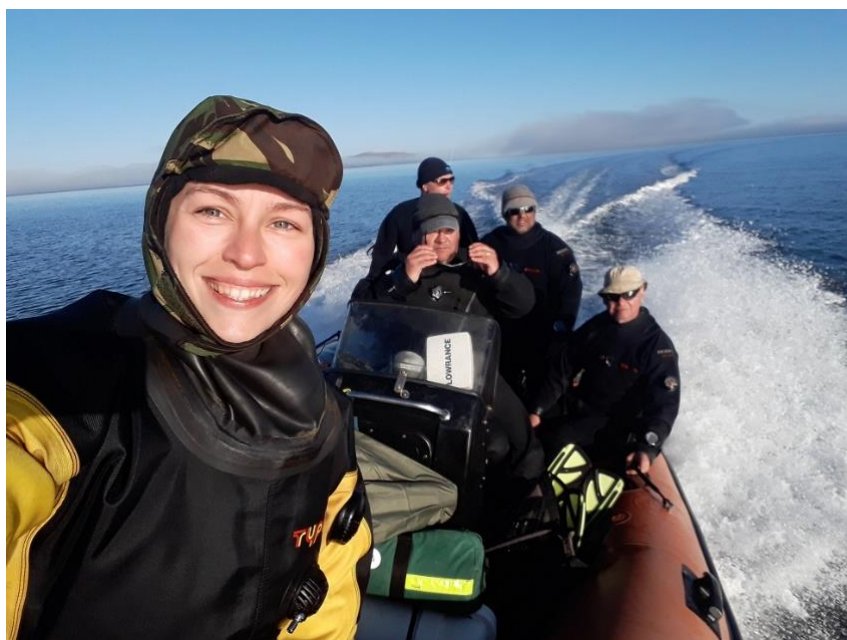

SAERI & SMSG survey Hummock Island

The Antarctic Research Trust (ART), who bought Hummock Island in 2018, invited the [Shallow Marine Survey Group](#) (SMSG) to survey the intertidal and subtidal waters. SAERI and SMSG teamed up for the 10-day dive trip to conduct the fieldwork with crucial support provided by Sally Poncet and Ken Passfield.

A baseline survey of the island was conducted, using SCUBA divers down to a depth of 20m. Extra footage was gained from deploying an ROV to deeper depths, and a CTD was also used to collect data on temperature, salinity and primary productivity. An assembly of images and video footage was captured, which can now be used for analyses as well as future guides and educational material.
