The nature of our work means that our teams are often required to work remotely, so the change to working from home should be relatively smooth. Our staff primarily work from laptops, and are equipped with the IT resources to accommodate work from home. This includes e-mails and conferencing facilities. This is to ensure that our staff keep safe, keep our community safe and indeed to maintain delivery of our projects and programmes. We will continue to review these arrangements, but at present they remain in place until the current guidance on non-essential travel and social distancing changes.
